Happy New Year

2023 was an eventful year for Converte with lots of activity, field days, seminars and international programs - here are some of the highlights:

- Converte completed the Future Drought Fund project with Debortoli Wines in the NSW Riverina, showing
 that our new slow release pellets help to boost soil biology, improve water retention and increase yield;
- Converte successfully applied and completed the 6 month GRDC Grains Challenge program with Cicada
 Innovations in Sydney. Here we were able to learn from senior Ag professionals and coaches and also share
 our wheat data with GRDC;
- Converte applied for and successfully completed the NSW Government Going Global Program for the United Kingdom, including exhibiting at World Agri Tech in London, meetings with the team at Australia House and a visit to Rothamsted Ag Institute;
- In 2023 we also completed the Regional Job Creation Fund capital works project with support of the NSW Government.

- We attended Ag events across the country, Wagin, Dowerin and Regen WA Field Days in WA, Mudgee,
 Henty, Riverina and Orange Field Days in NSW and Wimmera Field Days in Victoria;
- Isabel attended Evoke in Adelaide and the Digital Ag Conference in Wagga Wagga, and managed our R&D
 trial sites in NSW and VIC. She also managed to complete a masters in Agricultural Sciences in 2023!!
- Internationally we completed a further 40 independent crop trials and visited trial sites in faraway places;
- Some great crop results in the year including stand out high protein wheat crops in NSW achieved with reduced inputs, and excellent results with pastures and Lupins in WA. Our results showed boosted yields in wheat, chickpeas, tomatoes, grapes and potatoes;
- We are now preparing for an external capital raise and in discussions with strategic partners and investors.

There is more to come in 2024. We have an exciting year ahead, new staff joining our team, new international programs and kicking off with EVOKE in February in Perth.

Insights from the Field

2023 was a busy year data gathering here are some key highlights:

- use of biologicals in retaining yield is big business!! The more the crop is supported by biological processes
 and pathways the greater health and resilience is built.
- seed primer delivers 5% yield increase in wheat trials. Amazing to see the benefits of seed primer in cropping programs including 26% increase number of tillers and a 24% increase in root mass!! Improved germination rates and early access to water and nutrients carries through to yield increases.
- significant yield benefits of Converte biologicals in grapes 16%, tomatoes 19% and potato 22% trials;
- growing evidence of Converte biologicals adding resilience against rust and water stress in wheat. This is a key R&D focus for Converte in 2024, get in touch if you are interested in being part of this trial work.
