The last 12 months have been the usual roller coaster in the Ag industry. There has been a lot of caution out there and at the same time amazing growth in the Australian Ag tech industry. The bio input sector is growing rapidly and we have seen further key acquisitions in this space by the major international Ag players. Growing at about 15% per annum this sector is far outpacing the fertiliser industry and rapidly becoming a key element of agricultural thinking for this and the next generation of farmers.

To meet the growing demand for bio inputs Converte is keen to grow its business rapidly. In february Scott Glyde joined the business as our Director of Agribusiness and is part of a senior management team now leading the business forward. Scott is a wealth of knowledge and loves a yarn so reach out and start a conversation. We will be recruiting in a number of key areas over the coming months including, administration, product formulation, marketing and sales roles.



Specialist chemists and biologists in our team source key inputs from around Australia, including mined resources, up cycled materials from other Australian industries and materials naturally harvested from our inshore waters and coastlines.

These inputs are clean, locally sourced and arrive with a low carbon budget based on minimal kilometres travelled. At Converte we have unique expertise in

formulating these natural inputs into liquid and pelletised products that are easy for farmers to handle, super concentrated and integrate easily with current practices.



Hort Connections

In June 2024 Converte made its debut as an exhibitor at the Hort Connections national conference and exhibition in Melbourne. The timing could not be better for the company as it expands its operations from broadacre cropping, pasture systems and orchards into including horticulture proper. Converte now supply growers with biological companion products so that they can grow more with less, build resilient farming systems and make more profit.

Converte used the lock down period in 2020-22 to trial its bio-stimulant products across a range of horticultural crops. Managing Director John Ridley said, "We came to Hort Connections not just to showcase our products, but to show the real results we have achieved in independent trials. Over a couple of years Converte have built solid trial data on tomatoes, potatoes, turmeric, cannabis, lettuces,

grapes and more. We wanted to build grower confidence straight away that Converte products could be easily integrated into input programs and lead to measurable benefits in fertiliser and water use efficiency, plant health and resilience and ultimately yield retention. The trials incorporated seed treatments as well as liquid bio-stimulants applied to the soil and plant via boom sprays or via fertigation".

The key benefits of adopting Converte products would be:

- Nutrient Use Efficiency (ability to better control fertiliser inputs);
- Water Use Efficiency (better management of water resources and costs); and
- Plant health and resilience (healthier plants, less disease, less spraying of pesticides, improved yield retention).
